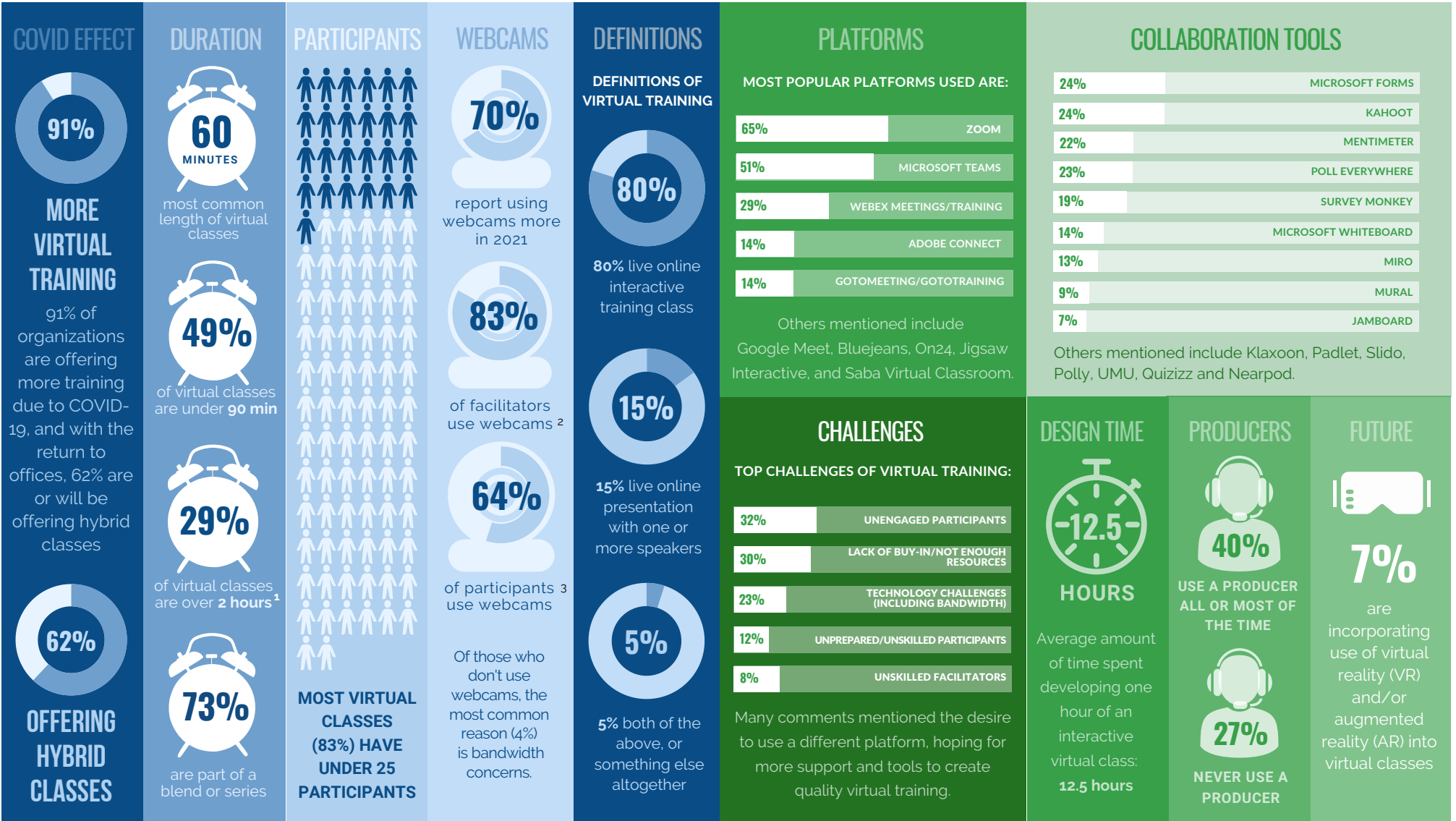


THE STATE OF VIRTUAL TRAINING 2022
